Jennifer Zhu Scott is a leading expert in **artificial intelligence**, **blockchain** and **data ownership**, with a deep understanding of these topics within a **Chinese context**, and in a **global** landscape.

She is the Founding Partner of IN. Capital, a platform focusing on Al and deep tech. She was previously the Executive Chairman of The Commons Project, a non-profit public trust to build digital goods as public service. She was earlier the Head of Business Development and Strategy in APAC for Thomson Reuters and an independent investor and advisor for fintech start-ups. She also cofounded one of the first education companies in China, which she successfully exited. In 2015, she founded Radian Partners, focusing on direct investments in renewable energy and deep tech.

Jennifer is a China Fellow of **The Aspen Institute** and has a dual Fellowship at **The Royal Institute of International Affairs (Chatham House)**. In 2021, she was named one of **The Most Influential Businesswomen in China** by Fortune and listed among **Forbes World's Top 50 Women in Tech** in 2018. She was co-chair of the **Fortune Global Tech Forum** in 2019. In 2014, Jennifer was appointed as one of the 18 council members of the China Council convened by the Global Agenda Council, the **World Economic Forum's think tank**. Jennifer was honoured by WEF as a Young Global Leader in 2013.

She studied Applied Mathematics at **Sichuan University** and has an MBA in Finance from **Manchester Business School**. She completed the public policy and leadership program at **Yale University** in 2013, at **Harvard Kennedy School** in 2016, and at **Oxford University** in 2017. She also graduated from the inaugural executive program on sustainability energy and leadership at **Princeton University** in 2018.

As well as advising the **World Economic Forum** on their Data Policy Council, the China Council and the Future of Blockchain Council, Scott is a **board trustee** of Web Science Trust and an **investment committee member** of Investcorp's eLysian Fund.

At Davos 2018, she debated against Nobel Prize winner Prof. Robert Shiller and Swedish Central Bank Deputy Governor Cecilia Skingsley on Crypto Assets. She is a consultant for Season 5 and 6 of the HBO show Silicon Valley and a frequent **public speaker** and **published author** on data ownership, Al, and digital monetary policies.

Jennifer speaks on Artificial Intelligence, FinTech, China macroeconomics and Sustainable Investment at a variety of events and conferences. Her TED Talk on data ownership alone has more than 3 million views. She has spoken at prestigious universities and world stages including Springer Nature Group's Leadership Summit in Athens and ULI Asia Pacific Summit.

She is a **lead author** and **co-author** of several white papers by the **World Economic Forum** on topics such as business technology adoptions, blockchain and the token economy. In addition, she is a **tech columnist** for **Caixin Global**.
